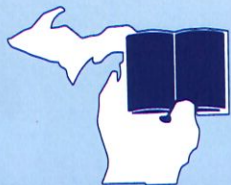
## ABOUT US

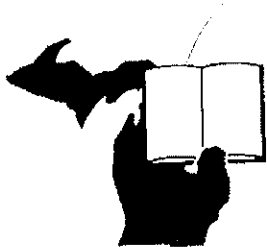
